On July 19th 2014, I went to Crescent Lake to monitor the landing area for any early detection signs of invasive species. According to the information I had, rusty crayfish were the only invasive species in the lake. I walked along the shoreline in the water looking for any shells of mystery snails or zebra mussels. I checked all washed up weeds looking for Eurasian water-milfoil or curly leaf pondweed. I used an aquascope to search in the water for any invasive plants and animals about 100 feet along the shore near the boat landing. I went as deep as I could before I lost visibility of the lake bed, which was about until the end of the dock. I checked the dock for any attached shells to it.

I did not find any indication of any more invasive species in the lake. There were many fish right around the dock with a good amount of plant life. The water seemed to be very clean and clear.
